All such work in connection with the operation of PNL for which you have completed the role training and have experience, including work in departments other than Stevedoring or contracted out to other stevedoring work (C3/SSL). Provide training in areas of operation where competent, in line with PNL Learner Guides. Maintain the PNL ASPIRE values. To be a positive and willing, contributing and adaptable member of the team at all times.
Health & Safety	<p>Operations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take an active role in ensuring safety of yourself and other members of the PNL team. Encourage a safety minded focus within your team and participate in the resolution of safety concerns. Adopt safe work practices, know the safety rules for your area, and comply with all standard operation procedures. Support the Company's Drug and Alcohol Programme. Actively participate in any rehabilitation programme. Use all appropriate safeguards, safety devices, safety equipment and personal protective equipment (PPE) provided.
