Job Purpose

- 1. Provide financial and strategic support for the operations business units, including both NZ and China Operations. A key focus is the recording and reporting of key operational metrics including labour and other costs, volumes and packhouse yields.
- 2. Supporting Project Managers for capital development projects ensuring budget tracking, forecasting and breaking down capital projects into capitalizable components.
- 3. Provide accounting support and ensuring best practice accounting and internal controls are adhered to.
- 4. To contribute to the positive process and culture of excellence within the organisation.

Responsibilities and role focus can be shaped depending on the experience and interest of the successful candidate.

Key Responsibilities

Operational Budgeting and Forecasting

- 1. Provide coolstore, packhouse inputs into the Company budget process
- 2. Update changes in postharvest volumes, yields, fruit sizing, sales pricing, etc as necessary and provide input into the Company forecasting models.
- 3. Provide input into budgeting and forecasting for operations related capital projects and capital expenditure.

Analysis and Reporting

- 4. Ensure detailed financial reporting by coolstore and packhouse vs budget is completed in a timely and accurate manner, reviewed and distributed to Operations Manager and the SLT.
- 5. Analyse and interpret key labour and cost trends and update management regarding their impact on the business.
- 6. Identify opportunities for revenue increase and / or cost reduction and work with the Operations team to implement.

Operations Metrics, Cost Tracking and Reporting

7. Timely and accurate reporting and variance analysis of operational metrics – bins in store, bins packed, yield, quality, RTE's produced, RTE's in store, inventory age, containers shipped etc



- 8. Ensure major costs are tracked and reported weekly against budget including labour, packaging, energy, R&M and other major coolstore and packhouse expenditure.
- 9. Maintain comprehensive multi-year packout data by orchard and lot for use in budgeting, investment and forecasting decisions
- 10. Ensure General Ledger reconciles with Labour input system (e.g. Lauranka)

China:

Rockit's China subsidiary has been recently set up to enable in-market packing of fruit and direct sales to new and existing customers.

- 11. Establish and document transaction flow between Rockit, its China Subsidiary and the Rockit Apple Growers Trust.
- 12. Providing support to the Rockit China Finance team and accounting advisers.
- 13. Oversee and review monthly reporting for Group Reporting Purposes
- 14. Support budgeting and forecasting for Rockit China

<u>Financial Accounting and Business Support:</u>

- 15. Assist in the preparation of accurate and timely month end reporting for Rockit entities and consolidated management accounts.
- 16. Supporting the yearend audit process and working closely with the business to gather information and overseeing yearend stock take procedures.
- 17. Support maintaining the Group's fixed asset registers.
- 18. Ensure appropriate controls, policies and efficient processes are being adhered to, to guarantee integrity, reliability, and support timely financial reporting and decision making.
- 19. Initiate and implement process improvement activities.
- 20. Any other tasks as required to support the finance function and wider business.

Organisational Obligations

- 1. Demonstrate company values.
- 2. Demonstrate commitment to health and safety and compliance with company policies.
- 3. Maintain a high standard of performance and commitment to internal and external customer service.
- 4. Ensure confidentiality of personal and business information.
